

WANT TO TRIAL FOR A REGIONAL SPORT TEAM?

- READ the Broadwater Trials Calendar. (Students must trial at Broadwater if they wish to be considered at the South Coast trial).
- WRITE down the trial date and venue for the Broadwater trial.
- EMAIL OR SEE Miss Taylor or Miss Austin with
 - the sport you are wanting to participate in,
 - your full name and date of birth
 - any previous sporting histories (as well as positions/scores)

before the listed 'Date to Nominate with Director of Sport' on the calendar. Nominations after this date will not be accepted.

- WAIT for an email from Miss Taylor (she is gaining approval from the Deputies as to whether you can represent the school and participate in this trial).
- When approved, Miss Taylor will email you the trial information and permission form for you to print and have your parents' sign

(If you need a hard copy of the permission form, please come to the sports hall for this). This form must be taken with you to the trial. Do not return it to the school.

CAN'T MAKE THE BROADWATER TRIAL?

If you are unable to attend the Broadwater trial, students can apply for an exemption. Please refer to the Broadwater Selection Policy below;

- In order for students to be selected in a Broadwater District team, they must be in attendance at the District Trials. The only exception to this is where:
 - Students are away at a sporting event of a higher level (in one of the sports approved by Qld School Sport). The District Trial Convenor must be notified of this prior to the start of the Trial.
 - Students have a medical certificate that is supplied to the Convenor prior to the start of the trials, covering the regional trial date.
