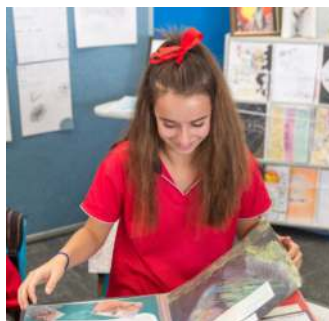
We have a number of internal support agencies covering many needs and the Study Centre is one of them.



ABOUT OUR CENTRE

The Study Centre provides and promotes a to students to help in the areas of English and Mathematics. The program consists of individual one-on-one tutoring and assistance provided to teachers and students in the classroom. Individualised support is designed around specific areas and needs of each student.

We have volunteer tutors who visit the school and spend time helping students with English and Mathematic skills as well as learning assistance in some subject areas.



For the English program attention is given to students to becoming more competent in the use of language skills, grammar, spelling and sentence construction. A guided reading program provides students the skills to increase speed and efficiency in reading.

The Mathematic program offers students a grounding in basic mathematics. Each student is given assistance in being able to understand the basic principles
