Detention Process



At Benowa State High School, students must meet expectations in terms of behaviour, attendance, uniform and being prepared for class. If a student is persistently late to school or class, is wearing incorrect uniform, or is not meeting workplace health and safety requirements through being prepared for high-risk classes, they need to bring a note of explanation. Additionally, students must behave in a manner that aligns with our Student Code of Conduct. The procedures regarding the detention process are as follows:

WEB Wellbeing Engagement Behaviour

Lunchtime detentions are issued in instances where students are:

- Persistently late to school or class without a valid reason
- · Wearing incorrect uniform without a valid reason
- Unprepared for high-risk classes, thereby not meeting workplace health and safety requirements, without a valid reason
- Behaving in a manner that does not align with our Student Code of Conduct

Afterschool detentions are issued in instances where students:

- Truant from class
- Behave in a manner that does not align with our Student Code of Conduct

Lunchtime detentions

- Lunchtime detentions are issued for the next school day and are held during second break (from 1:10 to 1:25pm) in R07
- Students will be notified via email, and this detention will appear on their Compass timetable
- Parents/Caregivers will be notified via Compass and SMS/push notification and will be directed to read Compass Detention correspondence

First afterschool detention

- In the event that a student does not attend their scheduled lunch time detention, they will automatically be issued an afterschool detention to be held the next applicable school day
- Afterschool detentions are held from 2:45 to 3:15pm on Mondays, Tuesdays and Thursdays in WEB (Room IRT1)
- Students will be notified via email, and this detention will appear on their Compass timetable
- Parents/Caregivers will be notified via Compass and SMS/push notification and will be directed to read Compass Detention correspondence
- Students may have their detention moved to another day by visiting a WEB Coordinator in WEB (Room IRT1)

Second afterschool detention

- In the event that a student does not attend their scheduled afterschool detention, they will automatically be issued a second afterschool detention to be held the next applicable school day
- Afterschool detentions are held from 2:45 to 3:15pm on Mondays, Tuesdays and Thursdays in WEB (Room IRT1)
- Students will be notified via email, and this detention will appear on their Compass timetable
- Parents/Caregivers will be notified via Compass and SMS/push notification and will be directed to read Compass Detention correspondence
- Students may have their detention moved to another day by visiting a WEB Coordinator in WEB (Room IRT1)

Suspension

• In the event that a student does not attend their second scheduled afterschool detention, or persistently refuses to meet school expectations in terms of uniform or behaviour, that equates to wilful disobedience, and the student may receive a suspension, during which time they will be unable to attend school
