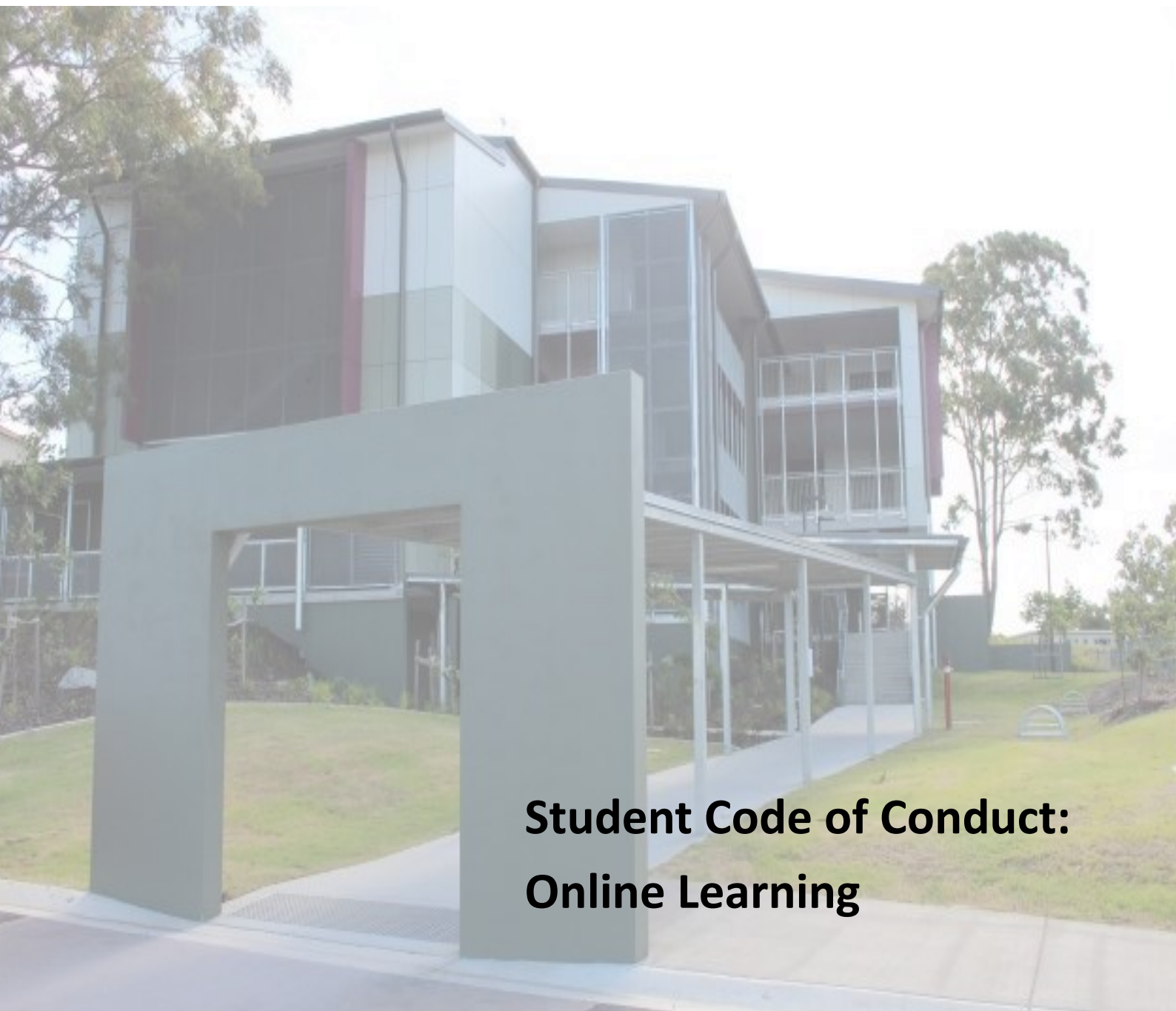

STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT: ONLINE LEARNING

Learning and Behaviour Statement

Benowa State High School promotes learning, creativity and innovation as the platform upon which to build prosperity and quality of life. We are strongly committed to our vision statement, "Many Pathways – No Limits" and provide a professional, inclusive, diverse and futures-orientated education that enables and strongly encourages all students to achieve their full potential.

Essential to an effective learning environment is the expectation for all members of the school community to conduct themselves in a lawful, ethical and responsible manner. Benowa's State High school sets high expectations for student conduct, and our four core values of Respect Integrity, Diligence and Compassion, underpin our Student Code of Conduct.

Our Student Code of Conduct includes behaviour on our physical and virtual campus, and platforms:

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Responsibilities of a student when using an online platform:

- Participate fully by meeting requirements which are based on return of work as outlined in the subject overview or teacher instructions, participate in scheduled lessons, engage with online course material, make regular contact with teachers and attend any face to face online school events / activities
- Follow appropriate protocols when engaged in online learning with teachers and other students: you are presented (dressed) appropriately on screen, are in an appropriate environment (be aware of your surroundings), behave appropriately as per the Benowa SHS Student Code of Conduct
- Check Daily Notices on the Benowa SHS Intranet each school day
- Use their EQ assigned webmail address for all communications with the school and take efforts to maintain communication through regular clearing of emails
- Ensure all assessment conditions are met as outlined in the Benowa SHS Student Assessment Policy found on the Benowa SHS website
- Ensure that the work you submit is your own. If you are unsure of this go to the Academic Integrity Course at myQCE / Learning Accounts / Student Portal
- Communicate with the school if you require further support with your learning

Responsibilities of parents/caregivers supporting a student at home on an online platform:

- Ensure your child participates to the best of their ability in the educational program in their timetabled subjects
- Ensure your child has the necessary equipment to be able to fully engage in a physical or an online learning environment. Contact the school if this is problematic

- Ensure that you comply with your legal obligation regarding compulsory schooling – details are contained with s.176 and s.178 of the Education (General Provisions) Act 2006 (QLD) ('the Act'):
- Section 176 (1) (b) of 'the Act' provides that each parent of a child of compulsory school age has the obligation to ensure their child is attending / engaging every school day for the educational program in which the child is enrolled
- Regularly check the Benowa SHS website for information relevant to school activities
- Ensure all assessment conditions are met as outlined in the Benowa SHS Student Assessment Policy found on the Benowa SHS website
- Ensure that work submitted by students is their own. If your child is unsure of this, please request they read the Academic Integrity Course at myQCE / Learning Accounts / Student Portal
- Communicate with your child's teacher if your child requires further support in their learning

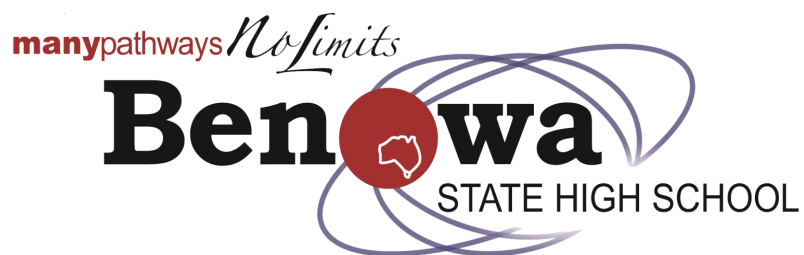
Responsibilities of the school in supporting an online learning environment:
