Elected Student Members

Eligibility

To be eligible for election as an elected student member, a person must:

- not have been convicted of an indictable offence, unless the Minister gives approval under the Act (s.93);
- be a student attending Year 10, 11 or 12 of the school;
- attend a meeting called for the purpose of electing student members; and
- submit a completed nomination on time.

Term of Office

The general term of office for an elected student member is a calendar year.

Election process

1. For the student election, the principal is the returning officer, or must appoint another person to be the returning officer for the election.
2. A student election may take place at the same time as (or combined with) other elections at the school involving students. For example, the election of the school's student leaders.
3. At least one but not more than two student members must be elected.
