This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students meeting NAPLAN minimum standard in Year 9 Reading from 95% to 96% and upper two bands from 14.7% to 22% (To national decile 7). Targets to 2017 will be national decile 8+.
- Increase the percentage of students meeting NAPLAN minimum standard in Year 9 Numeracy from 93.7% to 97% and upper two bands from 14.7% to 22% (To national decile 7). Targets to 2017 will be national decile 8+.
- Benchmark the NAPLAN minimum standards in Reading, Writing and Numeracy with the 2015 Year 7 cohort.

Our strategy will be to

... develop/source and implement:

- Diagnostic Tools (Naplan/QCS);
- Intervention Programs (Literacy/Numeracy);
- Teacher Professional Development (Literacy/Numeracy);
- Teacher Professional Development (ASOT);
- After school tutorial programs Junior Secondary/Senior Secondary;
- Study skills programs;
- Student well-being initiatives.
