

Benowa Medals

For students in years 7-9 who achieve exemplary grades in each of their subjects, demonstrate consistently excellent behaviour and effort, and activly participant in extra-curricular activities beyond the school.

Math Medallions

For one student in each grade with the highest total academic achievement in mathematics across the six year levels

Maths Diligence Award

For a year 12 student who consistently demonstrates exceptional effort, perseverance, and a strong work ethic in Mathematics. This award recognises commitment to learning, improvement, and resilience.

Science Laureate Award

This award recognises a student who has demonstrated exceptional academic excellence across multiple rigorous science disciplines. It celebrates a scholar whose dedication, intellectual curiosity, and consistent high performance have led them to achieve the highest overall average in their chosen science subjects.

STEM Ambassador of the Year

Recognises a student who embodies scientific curiosity, leadership, and community engagement. This student has gone above and beyond to share their passion for science—leading primary school outreach, organising Science Week activities, supporting school subject expos, and inspiring others through their enthusiasm and initiative. Their dedication to promoting science within and beyond our school community reflects the true spirit of a STEM leader and role model.
