This funding will be used to


- Implement specific strategies identified in the school's approved Annual Improvement Plan (AIP).

- Enable the school to target student learning improvement goals with a range of instructional and resource-based interventions.

Our initiatives include

- The designation of a Reading Coach, Writing Coach and a Numeracy Coach to assist staff and faculties with priority whole school action plans.
- The resourcing of evidence based interventions that will improve student learning or enhance the student learning environment.
- Partnership with QUT, QCAA and Queensland Principals' Association on the ARC-Linkage Project on assessment accessibility for students.

Action 4. Participating in the ARC-Linkage project with QUT and QCAA to position Benowa SHS as an early adopter of improved assessment practices.	\$10,000
